- TerraNova Next, Grades 2-8 (annually in February/March)
- Progress Monitoring:
 - NWEA MAP Testing (K-2), August, January, & April
 - DRC Beacon Testing (3-8), August, January, & April
- 8th grade students take the High School Placement Test, a local Catholic high school entrance exam.
- We use results from MAP, Beacon, and TerraNova tests, 6th grade math placement tests, and teacher recommendations for honors level math classes in middle school. We use the same criteria plus a writing sample for the honors level ELA classes.
